' TEJA SINGH GREWAL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP '

1. There shall be a scholarship\* called 'Teja Singh Grewal Memorial Scholarship' of the value of Rs. 225/- ~~per m.~~ payable out of the interest on the funds amounting to Rs. 20,000/- endowed by Professor M.C. Shukla, C-342, Defence Colony, New Delhi-110024 to perpetuate the memory of Late Shri Teja Singh Grewal who was formerly a lecturer in Shri Ram College of Commerce and Associate Director in School of Correspondence Courses and Continuing Education.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a student of the M. Com Part-II class in the University of Delhi who secured the highest percentage of marks at the M. Com Part-I Examination in the first attempt in the proceeding year.
3. In case, the student securing the highest marks in the M. Com. Part-I Examination as above is in receipt of any other scholarship as provided hereafter, the scholarship will be awarded to the next eligible candidate satisfying the above conditions.
4. The Scholarship shall be tenable for 10 months only from 1st July of an academic year to 30th April, of the same academic year (Next calendar year).
5. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he or she is already in receipt of a scholarship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the Central Govt. or any State of India or a private body other than a freeship.
6. In case the awardee under this endowment is awarded any other scholarship or gets financial aid from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other scholarship or financial aid.
7. In case a scholar discontinues studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the scholarship.
8. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Department of Commerce or the Principal of his/her college as the case may be on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the Bill the awardee was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
9. Any amount accruing from interest from the endowment and not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
