REPORT

The closing ceremony of GANDHI150 was celebrated in University of Delhi. University of Delhi The venue of the celebration was Gandhi Bhawan. The programme was started with a welcome by Prof. Ramesh C. Bharadwaj, Director, Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi. The Chief Guest on this occasion was Prof. P. C. Joshi, Acting Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi. Among others, Prof. Suman Kundu, Registrar, Prof. Rajiv Gupta, Dean, Student's Welfare and Prof. Anita Sehgal, Proctor, University of Delhi were present. To commemorate this event, at first, musical tribute of Mahatma - *Gandhiji ke priye bhajans* were presented by Prof. Shailendra Goswami, Faculty of Music, University of Delhi and his team. After *Ramdhun*, the Director, Gandhi Bhawan, presented a report on GANDHI150 programme/ events organized in the last two years (2018-2020). Among others, an instruction manual to manage Covid19 at home based on indigenous Indic knowledge, viz. Ayurveda, Yoga (pranayama), Meditation, Acupressure, Raga Therapy, Mudras and Pyramids was also showcased on this occasion.

On this occasion, Gandhi Bhawan, conferred the GANDHI150 award for outstanding performance to its Gandhi Study Circle of colleges of University of Delhi, propagating peace and Gandhian values among the fraternity. This award was divided into three categories viz., Principal, Convener and Student member/ volunteer, respectively.

The message of peace was delivered by Prof. P.C. Joshi, Acting Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi in which he emphasized the need of Gandhian values among youth today.

Taking all precautions of pandemic Covid19, the programme was organized with limited number of persons within permissible limits as per the directions of Govt. of India. The programme went off well.
